Native Lake Trout Discovered...

The DNR made an important discovery when netting fish on Elk Lake near Elk Rapids. Besides being the largest Lake Trout that the DNR had ever netted, it also had some noticeable differences in shape and color. Further research would show that the team discovered a native Trout species that had survived in Elk Lake. Most notably, Elk Lake was separated by a dam from Grand Traverse Bay and the Great Lakes over 100 years ago, and while the fish have survived in Elk Lake, they are no longer present in the Great Lakes. Warning E-15 Can Cause Damage!

We've been fortunate to have distributor that can still provide Ethanol-free gas at our fuel dock. The ability for you to keep ethanol out of your boat has certainly relieved a few headaches and kept countless related problems from spoiling your afternoon on the water. A Trade Only Magazine article recently stated: "The U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency & Renewable Energy recently released the results of two studies on the effects of using fuel that is 15 percent ethanol in volume in marine engines, and the reports showed significant problems with outboard, sterndrive and inboard engines, the National Marine Manufacturers Association reported. Results of the reports show severe damage to engine components and an increase in exhaust emissions, reinforcing the recreational boating industry's concern that E15 is not a suitable fuel for marine engines, the NMMA said."
